

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-06

WHEREAS, the City of Brundidge, Alabama advertised and directly contacted known qualified firms in order to obtain proposals for the provision of administrative services for CDBG Project No. SM-ED-PF-15-002, and

WHEREAS, based on the City's rating of the proposal using the City's rating system, Monroe & Associates, LLC is deemed most qualified for the services called for and the proposed contract price is considered appropriate and reasonable based on ADECA's allowable administrative costs, and

WHEREAS, Monroe & Associates, LLC is not debarred from work on federal contracts per the SAM.GOV search results attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Brundidge, Alabama to enter into a contract with Monroe & Associates, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brundidge, AL as follows:


SECTION 1. That based on the City's understanding of procurement policy of ADECA, the acceptance of the proposal of Monroe & Associates, LLC for the provision of professional services for the administration of CDBG Project No. SM-ED-PF-15-002 has been determined to be in the best interest of the City of Brundidge, AL, and that the proposed fee has been accepted as reasonable based on the complexity of the project.

SECTION 2. That the City of Brundidge, Alabama enters into an agreement with Monroe & Associates, LLC for the provision of administrative services, with said agreement attached hereto.

SECTION 3. That this action is based on the current interpretation of ADECA procurement policy which is acknowledged by this resolution and ADECA policy on file.

SECTION 4. That James T. Ramage, III in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Brundidge, Alabama.
