WHEREAS, the City of Brundidge requires administrative services to manage CDBG Project Number SM-ED-PF-15-002 also known as the North Industrial Park Expansion;

WHEREAS, the previous administrative contract has been terminated;

WHEREAS, the City of Brundidge has chosen to utilize the services of a regional planning and development commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the City Council of Brundidge as follows:


Section 1: That the method of procurement for professional services for CDBG Program purposes is governed by the Common Rule as revised by the ADECA in Policy Letter 1, Revision 9.

Section 2: That Policy Letter 1, Revision 9 states an applicant need not apply traditional procurement policies if it chooses to contract with a regional planning and development commission.

Section 3: That the City of Brundidge enters into an agreement with South Central Alabama Development Commission for the provision of administrative services, with said agreement attached herein.

Section 4: That James T. Ramage, III, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Brundidge.
